Purpose:

To establish a policy on how command of an incident will be transferred.

Policy:

Command will only be transferred to someone on location of the incident.

Command shall only be transferred to someone with a higher level of expertise or authority. That member shall use his/her discretion before assuming command.

The member in command shall provide a status report to the person assuming command face to face or if unable to complete face to face, over the radio.

A status report shall include the following:

- Description of what happened
- Whether anyone was/is injured or trapped
- What has been done so far
- Whether the problem has stabilized or is getting worse
- What resources are on scene or en-route

Once command has been transferred, the member now in command shall contact dispatch advising them of the transfer. Dispatch will announce the transfer.

Law Enforcement has authority at all traffic crashes unless there is a fire, or a significant haz-mat spill
