**Purpose:**

The purpose of this SOG is to establish guidelines for diverting radio traffic.

**Policy:**

WTG 4 will be the primary frequency used for all Fire and Rescue for Wintergreen, “on-property” calls.

In the event that radio traffic becomes heavy on property; the Wintergreen Dispatcher may divert rescue calls to a talk around frequency, such as WTG 5. Such times may include a working structure fire, heavy call volume during ski season, or other times deemed necessary by staff.

When working an incident on-property, radio traffic between apparatus and members may be diverted to a “talk-around” frequency. When directing traffic on the scene use WTG 5 or WTG 10.

When responding to and/or working calls in Nelson County, traffic may be moved to NCOP to allow dispatchers to tone additional calls or they may request you to use NCOP TA for talk around communications.

Members must pay attention to the frequency assignments.

Frequency diversion will be avoided whenever possible.
